

# A Message from our Executive Director

Combating Alzheimer's means fighting on multiple fronts. As we wait for a cure, Alzheimer's of Central Alabama will continue to offer services that make a real difference to families: **Project Lifesaver** to keep patients safe; **day care scholarships** to provide respite for caregivers while providing care that fosters each participant's unique skills and abilities; **continence supplies** that preserve dignity; and **education** to equip families with the skills they need. Our donors and supporters make this ministry possible.



These efforts build on ACA's history of supporting research, which includes funding 24 seed research grants at Alabama universities since 2001. ACA's Jr. Board, established in 2015, has attracted a dynamic group of young people who are ambitiously raising money for research with 2 major annual fundraisers: Glow for a Cure, a nighttime golf tournament in August; and Ales for Alzheimer's, a spring event at Avondale Brewery. In addition they host an annual educational event for their peers.

With Jr. Board support, ACA has established the Pre-Doctoral Scholars Program for Alzheimer's Disease Research at UAB. ACA will be supporting two students over the next three years with the goal of recruiting the brightest, most promising students to establish careers in Alzheimer's research.
